## FAMILLE BOURGEOIS

Situated a few kilometres away at the South-West of Sancerre, the Quincy appellation stands out by its compact territory surface and its micro-climate created by the influence of the Loire river called le Cher. Grape variety: 100% Sauvignon Blanc



This wine of a pale golden hue presents delicate citrus and white flower aromas. Fresh and lively yet round on the palate, 'Haute Victoire' is a well-balanced wine. Its fruity and very aromatic aspects add to its fine and elegant structure.

## JEAN-LOUIS ARDURATS

La Brède (Gironde)  
Situating right in the heart of Graves, in the village of La Brède, country of Montesquieu.  
A vineyard of 45 ha: 25 ha are planted with white Graves and 20 ha with red Graves.  
Grape varieties: 40% Sauvignon – 60% Semillon



Bright colour with elegant aromas: flowers, mint and licorice, delicately oaked. Supple and nicely rounded on the palate with fresh fruit aromas and spicy notes. Well balanced and delicate with a long finish.

## JOSEPH LANDRON

Located on the top of the Nantais vineyards on the hillsides of the Sèvre Nantaise this is where the Muscadet Sèvre et Maine appellation was created in 1926. A family vineyard of 35 ha of Muscadet grapes, grown on biological and biodynamical cultivations. Grape variety: 100% Melon de Bourgogne.



A fruity and slightly aromatic and refined wine. Should be drunk fresh when young. Its slight sparkle makes it an ideal Summer drink.

## MICHEL CHAPOUTIER

Michel Chapoutier took over the direction of the winery in 1990, which is still independent and family owned. He converted the entire estate to biodynamic farming.



Colour: pale, yellow and clear.  
Nose: green apple, hawthorn and white blossoms, citrus aromas and exotic fruits.  
Palate: fresh and well-balanced, lots of body.

## FAMILLE LEDUC-FROUIN

Leduc-Frouin estate consists of 30 ha located in Anjou in the beautiful Loire Valley, between Angers and Saumur in the heart of the high Layon.

Varieties cultivated are Cabernet franc and Grolleau used to make Rosé wines.



With generous and fresh red berries on the nose and a crunchy character our rosé wines offer a harmonious expression of strawberry, raspberry and blackcurrant. They can be enjoyed as an aperitif, during a meal or anytime, just for pleasure.

## ISABELLE REY-AURIAT

The plots of land of Château Les Hauts d'Aglan are located on the high terrace of the right bank of the Lot Valley where the soils are clayey and chalky.

Grape varieties: 90% Cot (Malbec) and 10% Merlot.



The rich red delivers a juicy array of blackberry and raspberry flavours that are ripe and robust. It's a wine with a firm structure. Spicy and luscious on the mocha and chocolate infused finish.

## ROSELYNE GAVOTY

Located 50 km from the sea behind the barrier of the Maures hills, this 43 hectare estate owned by the same family since 1806 undergoes climatic extremes due to the continental influence. The soil is clay and limestone (triassic plateau).

Grape varieties: Cinsault, Grenache mainly and occasionally Syrah.



Its colour is pale pink, with a delicate fresh fruit nose. Its softness and fullness make it an ideal accompaniment for the most delicately textured fish such as turbot, monkfish, rock lobster, etc.

## XAVIER & DAMIEN PAGÈS

Between the Atlantic Ocean and the Gironde Estuary Château Noaillac benefits from a temperate climate giving it a full-bodied 'on the fruit' character, subtle with excellent tannins.

Grape varieties: 55% Merlot Noir, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot.



Grown from sustainable agriculture, this wine shows a beautiful concentration, a deep red-purple colour with dark highlights. The palate is dense, rounded and unctuous sustained by long lasting tannins expressing the ageing capacity of this Médoc.

**ANJOU**  
**O. LECOMTE & F. DAVID**

The Château de Passavant winegrowing estate is located along the Layon river. Made up of 90% matured Cabernet Franc & 10% very fruity Grolleau Noir. Every Château de Passavant vineyard has been cultivated according to the rules of organic agriculture since 1998.



This outstanding Val de Loire red wine, very light in tannins, has a predominately mature red and black fruit flavour emphasised by a smoky mineral touch.



**VALLÉE DU RHÔNE**  
**FAMILLE PERRIN**

The southern slopes of the Mont Ventoux (1912 metres/ 5736 feet), 25 km/40 miles to the east of Orange. Grape varieties: Grenache 50%, Syrah 20%, Carignan 15% and Cinsault 15%. The wine is kept in both vats and large oak barrels for ten months, then bottled in July.



Appearance: deep cherry red.  
Nose: ripe fruit, rich and spicy.  
Palate: good solid red wine with pleasant tannins.



**VALLÉE DU RHÔNE**  
**S. & F. BARNAUD**

It is halfway between Montélimar and Avignon, on the highly specific 'terroir' of Rousset Les Vignes favourable to the making of great wines, that the Domaine La Bouvaude and its 34-acre vineyard are located. Soil type: siliceous shale on hillside. Vintage blend: 80 % Grenache, 20% Syrah.



On the nose, this vintage is very fruity and nicely complex. It has a ruby red colour with purple glints. On the palate, it has a full and pleasant texture with notes of ripe berries and a slight hint of acidity which makes it fresh. It's fruity, it's tasty: it's 'Fruilandise'.



**LANGUEDOC**  
**FAMILLE DARDÉ**

Near to Sète on the Mediterranean coast, Jean-Paul, Michel and Sylvain Dardé cultivate the domain of 70 hectares. The plots are located on a clayey-calcareous soil, which combined with the maritime influence make the development of fresh, fruity and elegant wines possible. Grape variety: 100% Syrah



Intense nose marked by spices and silky aromas. The mouth is full, round, smooth, slightly spicy, with discreet oak barrel tannins. All is softness and sweetness.
